Welcome to the Sutton Coldfield Pokéclub where you can play the Pokémon trading card game, swap cards or play Pokémon video games on your DS with other fans of Pokémon. Our club normally meets twice a month. As well as our normal league meetings we also host occasional tournaments including the Pokémon TCG Birmingham City Championships. Don't worry if you're new to the trading card game, beginners are always welcome and there's always other players on hand who will be willing to help you learn the game. Just bring along your DS, game cartridge and trading cards and join in the fun.

If you've never played Pokémon at a league or event before we'll give you a player ID number. This will allow you to enter official Pokémon tournaments and you can also use it to create a Pokémon trainer account online at [www.pokemon.com](http://www.pokemon.com).

We ask players to pay £2 at each league meeting to cover the cost of renting the hall.

Pokéclub is a public event and anyone of any age is welcome to attend. However parents need to be aware that the club does not provide a child care service and you remain responsible for your child's safety, well-being and behaviour. Parents are welcome to stay during all meetings and tea and coffee is available free of charge. Toilet facilities are also on site. Any help from parents putting out chairs and tables, making drinks etc is greatly appreciated.
